About Rusk County Groundwater Conservation District (District)

The District was authorized in 2003 by the 78th Texas Legislature under HB 3569 and confirmed by election of Rusk County citizens June 5, 2004. The District's mission is to develop and implement a sound groundwater management program to protect and sustain the groundwater resources of the District. Governed primarily by the provisions of Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code. The District has the capability and authority to undertake various studies to promote conservation, establish a program for the registration and permitting of water wells, implement structural facilities, non-structural programs to achieve its statutory mandates, and rule-making authority.

Primary Roles and Responsibilities

The Rusk County Groundwater Conservation District is seeking applications for the position of General Manager. The GM is responsible for the day to day activities of the District and reports directly to the District Board of Directors. Responsibilities include (but are not limited to): functioning as the general administrative agent responsible for the design, development, and implementation of policies approved by the Board of Directors in order to meet District objectives for the protection, management, and conservation of groundwater within the District. Duties include overall supervision of District staff; overseeing and participating in data collection; involvement in District and Regional water supply planning, and policy development; development of the District Budget; preparation of reports for the Board, TCEQ, TWDB and other entities; oversee and conduct public speaking and public education activities, must present a positive image as representative of the District in appearance and demeanor, must set an example as a leader in promoting the goals and objectives of the District within the community; drafting of rules; preparation for audits; and ensuring that District Management Plan Objectives are achieved.
