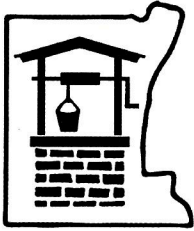

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RUSK COUNTY GROUNDWATER
CONSERVATION DISTRICT’S BOARD OF DIRECTORS
APPROVING ITS FEE SCHEDULE**

WHEREAS, the Rusk County Groundwater Conservation District (“District”) was created and charged by the Texas Legislature to provide for the conservation, preservation, protection, and prevention of waste of groundwater, and of groundwater resources in Rusk Counties, under Act of May 28, 2003, 78^h Leg., R.S., ch. 764, 2003 Tex. Gen. Laws (HB 3569), §36.0015, Tex. Water Code, and Section 59 of Article XVI of the Texas Constitution;

WHEREAS, pursuant to §36.205, A district may set fees for administrative acts of the district, such as filing applications. Fees set by a district may not unreasonably exceed the cost to the district of performing the administrative function for which the fee is charged;

WHEREAS, the District finds that is reasonable to assess fees for the staffs’ administrative functions, including but not limited to the processing of permits, registrations, well inspections, and copies, that are appropriate to the cost of the District staff performing the administrative function;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RUSK COUNTY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT THAT:


THE DISTRICT ADOPTS THE ATTACHED FEE SCHEDULE AS ITS OFFICIAL FEE SCHEDULE.

The motion passed with 8 ayes, and 0 nays.


